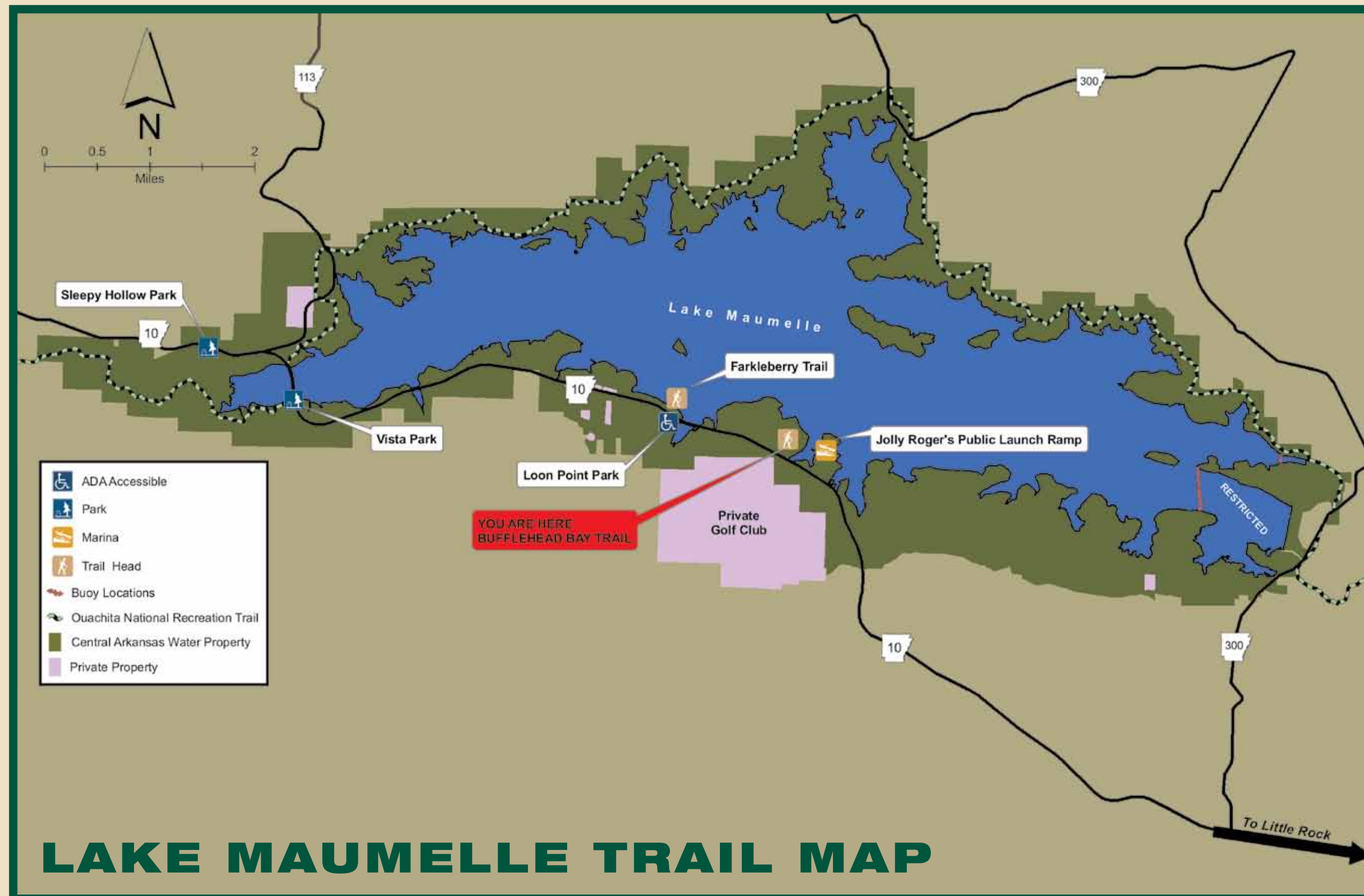




Bufflehead Bay Trail



Lake Maumelle, created in 1958 for \$9 million, is a major source of drinking water for about 400,000 people in and around Little Rock. Central Arkansas Water owns the lake, which covers 8,900 acres (about 14 square miles), and about 9,000 acres of land around it. 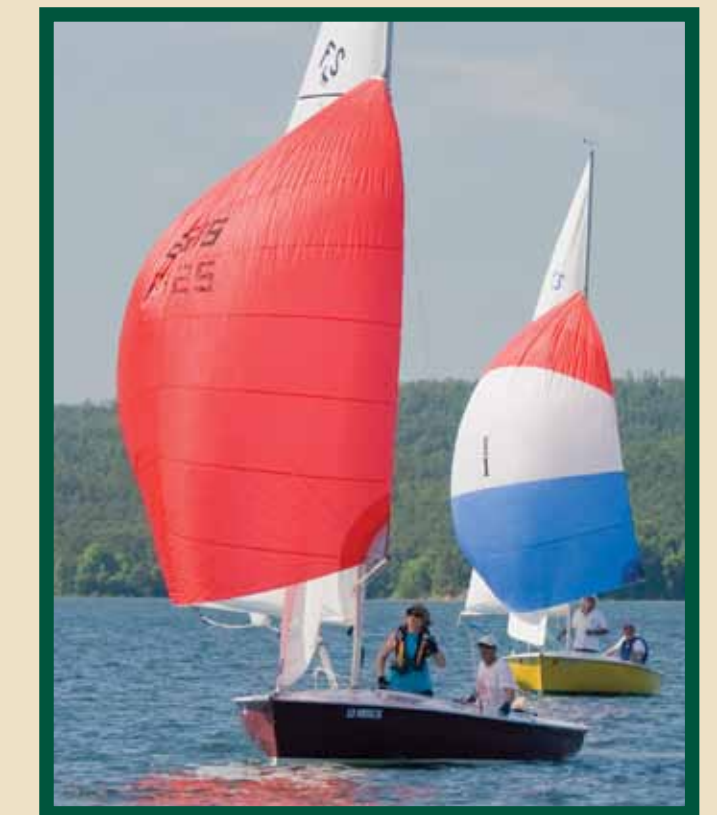

Anglers pursue largemouth bass, spotted bass, white bass, crappie, catfish, bream and other species, especially in vegetation and around rocks and stumps. Hunting occurs near Lake Maumelle. Check fishing and hunting regulations at www.agfc.com, and wear hunter orange when appropriate.

Bufflehead Bay Trail, 0.2 miles one way, is an out-and-back hike with views of Lake Maumelle. Foot traffic only.
