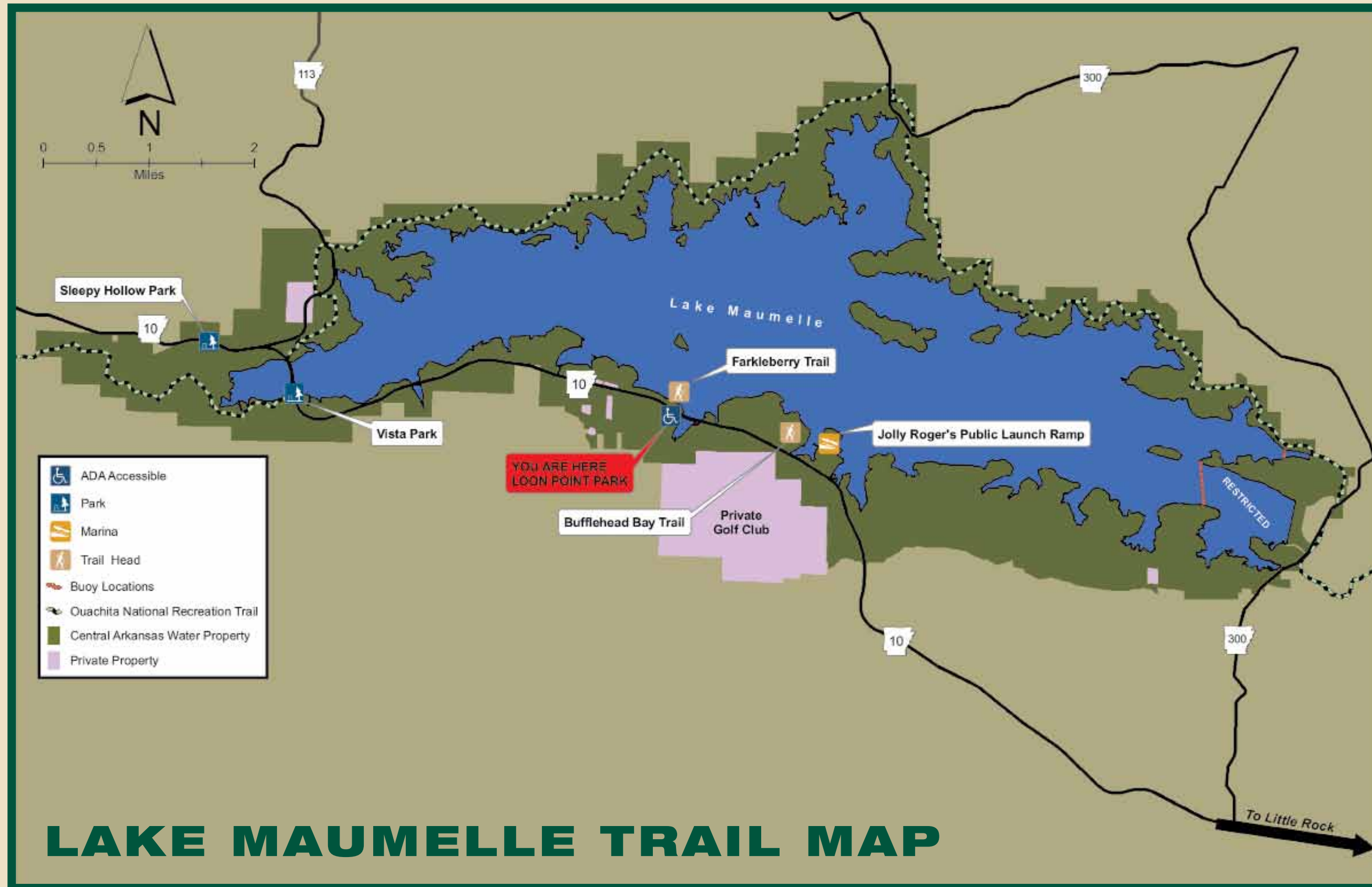




# Loon Point/ Farkleberry Trail



**The Loon Point/Farkleberry Trail, 0.13 miles one way, is an out-and-back hike with views of Lake Maumelle. Continue through picnic area to begin. Foot traffic only.**

The Maumelle River is the largest source of water for Lake Maumelle. The Maumelle Watershed, which covers about 137 square miles, stretches into Perry County, 40 miles west of the lake. Rain washes sediment, debris and chemicals through the watershed, into the river and the lake. To preserve the excellent water quality of the lake, visitors must be good caretakers of the watershed.
